

## **Section 33 Visual Arts and Music Grant Eligibility Requirements Checklist**

- Staffing:** A teacher with a JX, JQ, LQ, LX or LZ endorsement issued by the department for every 400 pupils enrolled in grades K to 5 has been hired OR a teacher will be hired and there is a commitment to notify the MDE when the teacher is hired.
  
- Curriculum:** A specific curriculum for visual arts or music has been adopted and implemented.
  
- Materials and Tools:** Physical materials and tools needed for visual arts or music instruction that will be provided either using these grant dollars or other resources are described and aligned with the curriculum description/map.
  
- Schedule:** A schedule is provided that shows at least 60 minutes per week of instruction in visual arts or music.
  
- Space:** A clear description is provided of the designated space for visual arts or music instruction that makes sense given the curriculum description/map and number of students.
  
- Budget:** The budget provided is allowable, reasonable and supports the implementation plan for the visual arts or music program.
  
- Data Collection:** Agree to participate in data collection for the visual arts or music program.
  
- Continuous Improvement:** Agree to commit to including music or visual arts in district and school continuous improvement planning.
  
- Michigan Blueprint of a Quality Arts Education:** Agree to adopt and implement a plan to satisfy the recommendations listed in the Michigan Blueprint of a Quality Arts Education program.
