## Section 33 Visual Arts and Music Grant Eligibility Requirements Checklist

<b>Staffing:</b> A teacher with a JX, JQ, LQ, LX or LZ endorsement issued by the department for every 400 pupils enrolled in grades K to 5 has been hired OR a teacher will be hired and there is a commitment to notify the MDE when the teacher is hired.
<b>Curriculum:</b> A specific curriculum for visual arts ormusic has been adopted and implemted.
<b>Materials and Tools:</b> Physical materials and tools needed for visual arts or music instruction that will provided either using these grant dollars or other resources are described and aligned with the curriculum description/map.
<b>Schedule:</b> A schedule is provided that shows at least 60 minutes per week of instruction in visual arts or music.
<b>Space:</b> A clear description is provided of the designated space for visual arts or music instruction that makes sense given the curriculum description/map and number of students.
<b>Budget</b> : The budget provided is allowable, reasonable and supports the implementation plan for the visual arts or music program.
<b>Data Collection:</b> Agree to participate in data collection for the visual arts or music program.
<b>Continuous Improvement</b> : Agree to commit to including music or visual arts in district and school continuous improvement planning.
Michigan Blueprint of a Quality Arts Education: Agree to adopt and implement a plan to satisfy the recommendations listed in the Michigan Blueprint of a Quality Arts Education program.
